1. Relevance and significance of the developed scientific problem

The **relevance** of the topic chosen for this thesis is undeniable in the methodology of language teaching. The increasing penetration of the competence approach in all areas of university teaching, including foreign language teaching, requires a change in teaching methodology and the transition to integrated learning of subject content and foreign language.

The **significance** of the research is determined by the fact that the proposed theoretical model, which meets the needs of such training, has been approbated among students of the Faculty of Economics of the University of Tirana studying Business English as part of their studies.

The good scientific style and terminological accuracy are very impressive. The text is easy to read and accessible, which demonstrates the author's high academic culture and responsibility.

2. Compliance with the national requirements for a PhD thesis

The research submitted by PhD student Eda Cauli and the accompanying documents fully comply with the requirements of the Academic Staff Development Act of the Republic of Bulgaria and its Implementing Regulations.

3. Assessment of the scientific results and the contributions of the dissertation

4. Evaluation of theoretical and applied contributions

Among the **theoretical contributions** of this dissertation the following can be highlighted

- This is the first attempt to explore the integrated learning of subject content and foreign language in English language teaching in a university setting in Albania

- The proposed model has been validated through an experimental study, and the results presented meet the current requirements for conducting academic research and therefore contribute to the pedagogical practice of foreign language teaching.

Contributions of an applied nature:

- The author offers practical tools for the application of the methodology in the planning, implementation and verification of a modern approach to learning English in business and administrative technology and communications.

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4. Evaluation of the PhD student's publications and the thesis abstract

The five publications presented by Eda Cauli on the topic of her dissertation (2018-2021) are in the direction of her research and can provide representativeness of the findings and results. One of them has been published in Albania and the others in international journals of Romania, Greece and Austria.

The abstract is written in accordance with the requirements. It fully complies with both the Academic Staff Development Act of the Republic of Bulgaria and its Implementing Regulations. The abstract fully reflects the spirit and content of the thesis.
